***Pediatrics* Editorial Board Member Responsibilities**

- Be an ambassador for the journal and its overall mission to provide ongoing information that will improve the health of children.
- Promptly and thoroughly review 15-20 articles annually within 2 weeks after receipt.
- Write or recruit at least one short commentary annually on an important article you have reviewed.
- Recruit articles for submission to *Pediatrics* from your colleagues.
- Declare a conflict of interest if asked to review an article that in any substantive way would present a conflict; also declare if you are a member of another editorial board.
- Share ideas for improvements in and constructive criticisms about *Pediatrics'* policies and content (print and online versions).
- Recommend qualified individuals to fill open positions on the *Pediatrics* Editorial Board and to serve as reviewers.
- Solicit ideas and opinions from your colleagues and residents regarding content and utility of the journal.
- Attend the *Pediatrics* Editorial Board annual meeting that is held in conjunction with the AAP National Conference and Exhibition. Participate on the mid- year board conference call.
